

Stirling Truck Show Circle Check Competition

Pre trip inspection eligibility rules

1. Competitors must hold a valid A-Z drivers license.
2. License must be issued by the province of Ontario.
3. Competitors must currently be employed as a full time Professional Truck Driver.
4. A competitor whose principle employment is for the movement of vehicles on private property and who is general referred to as a spotter, hostler, switcher, yard man, or other similar discretion is eligible to compete.
5. The Stirling Truck Show community reserves the right to check all applications and disqualify any competitor who does not meet the above requirements, or who is deemed to be guilty of conduct detrimental to the Stirling Truck Show or to the Trucking Industry. The decision of the committee is final.
6. Each competitor must forward an official entry form signed and witnessed to the chair of the Stirling Truck Show by the designated dead line.

Categories of Competition

There will be one category of competition at the Stirling Truck show.

1. Tandem- axle tractor and tandem- axle – Semi trailer

Equipment Specifications

Competitors may not inspect their own equipment all competitors must inspect equipment provided by the Stirling Truck show committee.

Equipment provided will meet the specifications detailed below.

1. Tandem axle tractor 3 axles.
2. Tandem axle -Semi trailer 2- axle trailer with a minimum overall length of 45 feet.

General Rules and Procedures

1. Appearance – No points are awarded. A neat, tidy appearance, appropriate dress and a professional attitude are expected
2. Grounds for disqualification by the judges are:
 - * Obscene language or displays of temper.
 - * Use of alcohol or drugs.
 - * Failure to proceed when directed by the judge.
3. Inspections will be timed from start to finish, from the start line to the finish line, except for emergency time outs.
4. Emergency time out- If you experience a medical or other emergency situation during your inspection you may request an emergency time out. Communicate your request to the nearest available judge by the best available means. The timer will stop timing.
5. Unprofessional or offensive conduct or appearance could lead to a disqualification at the discretion of the judge.
6. No more than the maximum points will be deducted during the inspection; you cannot receive a negative score. If you receive the maximum point deduction for the inspection the judge will advise you that you have exceeded the maximum deduction and stop the inspection.
7. You may opt to remove yourself from the inspection at any point in your inspection. Full points will be deducted for any missed inspections criteria.

Scoring

1. The total amount of points awarded throughout the inspection is 50.

*** Bonus points are not awarded for time.

Points will be deducted from your total score according to the following schedule:

At or below 8 minutes	No deduction
First 29 seconds over the 8 minutes	5 points
From 30 - 59 seconds over 8 minutes	10 points in addition
From 60 - 74 seconds over 8 minutes	15 points in addition
More than 75 seconds over 8 minutes	20 points in addition

The maximum deduction is 50 points.

CIRCLE CHECK / DEFECTS

Maximum value is 50 points. You must complete a circle check and must follow a systematic routine within the specified time. A sample routine is provided .

For all Tractor-Trailer competitors, the test will be conducted on a tractor-trailer. Maximum time is eight (8) minutes.

The vehicle will have five defects, which you are expected to locate and describe. 8 points are awarded for each defect you find. The defects will be detectable without starting the vehicle or turning on any lights. A list of possible defects will not be provided. 10 points are awarded for a proper systematic inspection.
